## Class Supplies:

- Supply List for Cloisonné Enameling Exploration
- There will be a \$30 fee per student for use of Teacher supplied consumables (sanding discs, counter enamel, distilled water, mask for sifting, drafting tape, opaque white for enamel samples, tracing paper to cut foil, etc.).
- The Metal Arts Guild of Georgia will provide the following for student use during class: Torches, kiln, trivets, sifters, kiln gloves and glasses, kiln firing forks, Klyr-Fire and an array of leaded and unleaded transparent enamels.
- All of the supplies below will be available for purchase from Jody during classes (usually in smaller individual amounts so you can try things and see if you like them). Links are listed in case you want to purchase anything in larger quantities. Also feel free to bring what you have from your studio and like using.
- Required Enameling Supplies:
  - Copper Sheet 24g-22g 6" x6" or 24g-22g Round Copper Blanks - JewelrySupply.com has very reasonable prices for copper blanks
  - Cloisonné Wire - recommend 0.05" x 0.004" (1.27 x 0.102mm) but ok to have other sizes

  - Selection of Leaded and/or Unleaded Enamels:
    - 1. Flux (I use Ninomiya N3 leaded but other good ones are Hirasawa S-1S, Nihon Shippo G110 for Silver, Soyer #3 (all leaded), Thompson 1020 (unleaded).
    - 2. Counter-enamel (can be any color. Black, dark blue or dark green are very stable colors for counter enamel and can be opaque or transparent)
    - 3. A variety of transparent enamel colors
    - 4. Blythe T-8 Opalescent enamel
    - 5. Nihon Shippo G-710A Translucent White
    - 6. Nihon Shippo 209 or 210 Semi-Opaque White
  - Small 40 Mesh Sifters

  - Long Handle Tweezers - for moving hot objects
